Turned into Miles Moretti, UDWR and sent to rehaber Marilyn Bicking, Moab. Died on her next day. It was very thin and had a broken skull near the base of the bill and a large heamatoma on the back (perhaps hit on the road or else landed very hard on the road)

appears to be an imm with new central rectrices coming in about 5 mm shorter than the rest of the tail feathers. hard to find gonads but appeared to be a male.

I think I will do something on feeding of cedar waxwings in Utah rather than the owls in Beaver Dam Wash. I will not have time to get to it until I retrun to Utah on 12 Dec.
