HEAD WAS POLDLY BLACK & WHITE STRIPED - WITH WHITE BEING THE CENTER STRIPE, BORDERED BY BROADER BLACK STRIPES, THEN WITH A WHITE EYE BROW and a CLARK EYE STRIPE (THROWH LORES TO BACK OF HEAD) CHEER THROAT, NECK AND VENTRAL SURFACE WAS GRAYISH WITH Some BROWN SPOTTING.

BACK & WINGS WERE GRAYISH BROWN WITH SOME LIGHTER GRAY-BRO SPOTTING. DARK PRIMARIES
