No. Parula Warbler.

Seen Dec 13th 1990. in the Trees in front and back of the Red Iguana Restaurant. 736 N. North Temple. The Bird was first observed at 10 AM by myself and then again at 11:30 by Craig Keeley & myself. Total the Bird was observed for 45 minutes from distance ranging from 6 ft to 50 ft. The bird was observed thru 8 x 24 binoculars in bright light conditions. The weather was cloudy - That night it snowed & there left up to 4 inches of snow in this area. The Warbler was quite small seeming about $\frac{1}{2}$ the size of a ♀ House Sparrow seen next to the Bird on one occasion. The Bird was quite active primarily feeding on apples from the Trees in front of the Restaurant. The Warbler was generally bluish gray on top with a greenish ^{upper} back patch, the belly of the Bird was white or were the concolorous areas. The Throat & Breast were yellow with the yellow extending up thru the chin & lower Bill (sternum mandible) across the yellow Breast were two bands of color one ~~dark~~ dark almost the color of the back and another band a rust color. The Warbler has a split Eye Ring, similar to a Mac gillivray's Warbler. a dark line split the Eye Ring. The Bird had a short tail.
