

Town Dove Sighting Oct 30 1992.
 Little Ranch Beaver Dam Wash. Washington co. Idaho.

5 Town Dove were Sighted Oct 30, 1992 near
 the Little Ranchhouse in Beaver Dam Wash. Washington co. Idaho.

The Dove ~~were~~ had small rounded heads and a small
 plump beak - rather pigeon like. The grayish plumage
 on the head, nape, throat, chest and belly was scaly looking or
 scalloped. While sitting on the ground the relatively long
 tail had a conspicuous white edge. At the bird flew
 a rusty red was evident in the upper wing.

The Dove were seen from a distance of approx 35 feet
 using 8.5 x 44 Swift Audubon Binoculars. They were seen
 in full view ~~in~~ about a scrubby shrubby area near the
 Ranchhouse. The weather was cloudy with slight rain.
 The time of day was 3:20 pm. There were viewed for
 25 minutes.

The observer has seen ^{several} other Town Dove in Arizona
 and has one other sighting in Idaho in the town of
 Warminster in 1990.
