THE BIRD WOULD VISITE SPORADIRALLY, ONCE OR TWICE

PER HOUR. IT WOULD ZIP IN, NORMALLY PERCH, DRINK,

AND THEN LEAVE, ALMOST ALWAYS IN THE SAME DIRECTION. Behavior:

Habitat: OPEN CANYON WITH SMALL RIPARIAN COERIDOR AND PINYON JUNIPER SLOPES.

What similar species might it have been and how were these eliminated:

- BLACK-CHINNED, ALSO PRESENT, HAS PURPLE AND BLACK THROAT AND IS NOTICABLY SMALLER.
- BROAD -TAILED HAS RED GORGET, BUT NOT CROWN, AND HAS LOUD CRICKET-LIKE TRILL OF WINGS WHEN FLYING, ABSENT IN THIS BIRD.
- COSTA'S IS SMALLER, GORGET MORE ELONGATE AND VIOLETTE. What experience have you had with this and similar species:

EXPERIENCE WITH LOCAL BROADSTAILS, BLACKCHINNEDS, AND COSTA'S AS WELL AS EASTERN ROBY THROATS. RUFOUS HUMMERS PASSON THROUGH EN MASSE IN THE FALL.
