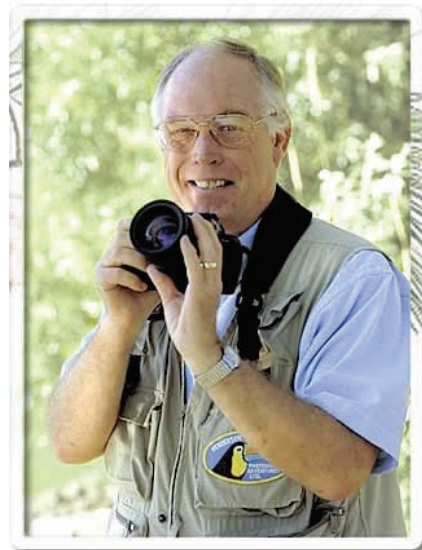
Enhancing Nature Tourism Experiences

Friday, September 7, 2007 - 7:00 p.m.

Carrol is the Supervisor of Minnesota's Department of Natural Resources' Nongame Wildlife Program. He has a special interest in wildlife tourism and has been instrumental in promoting wildlife tourism in Minnesota by partnering with ExploreMinnesota Tourism to sponsor workshops for the hospitality industry, chambers of commerce, B & B's, outfitters and natural resource specialists. He has helped with the creation of Minnesota birding trails and has given presentations at bird festivals throughout the state. Carrol and his wife, Ethelle, have led more than 40 birding tours to Latin America, Kenya, Tanzania and New Zealand since 1987. Carrol is an avid photographer and has a collection of over 50,000 photos of nature and wildlife. Carrol has also published several books, including, "The Traveler's Guide to Wildlife in Minnesota," "Field Guide to the Wildlife of Costa Rica," "Oology and Ralph's Talking Eggs."

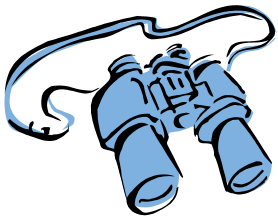

The 2007 Utah Ornithological Society Fall Conference will be held September 7-8-9, in Provo, Utah. The event is being co-sponsored by Utah County Birders, the Monte L. Bean Life Science Museum at Brigham Young University and the Utah Office of Tourism.

Accommodations: A block of rooms has been set aside at LaQuinta Inn, Provo Town Center, 1460 South University Ave., Provo, UT 84601. **Exit #263 from I-15.** Telephone: (801) 374-9750. When calling for reservations, you must tell them it is for the "Utah Birdwatchers" conference. A special rate of \$75.00 is being given for Thursday, Friday & Saturday nights.

Registration: You must pre-register for the conference by completing and mailing the form below. **Deadline is September 4.** Late registrations may be accepted; call the numbers shown on the form after September 4. Conference check-in will be in the LaQuinta Inn lobby from **5:00pm to 7:00pm** on Friday evening; and from **8:00am to 9:00am** at the Bean Museum on Saturday morning. Your registration fee pays for the Friday evening social as well as Saturday morning breakfast snacks at the Bean Museum prior to the paper session.
